

Study trip to Santiniketan

A study trip was organised by the department of History to Santiniketan from 29/11/24 to 01/12/2024 as part of their SEC syllabus. Twenty (20) students (14 from semester III Major and Four from semester V major) along with four (4) faculty members namely Dr.Parnasabari Bhattacharyya, Dr. Suchandra Guha, Md. Jiaul Anam Molla and Sri Krishna Sarkar began their journey from Howrah station by Santiniketan Express at 10.05 in the morning. The entire tour was planned and executed by 'Seemana periye' a tour and travel agency. Students and teachers were lodged at 'Santiniketan Hotel'. The trip was planned in the following manner: Day 1. Visit to 'Srijani Shilpa Gram, Surul Zamindar house and Amar Kutir (a co-operative). Day 2: Visit to Visva-Bharati campus followed by Sonajhuri fairground. As per syllabus students interacted with local folk artists (Bauls) and participated in folk dance. They gathered first-hand experience about folk culture of Bengal.
