

National Youth Day

National Youth Day was commemorated jointly by anti-Ragging Committee and NSS. The first programme was a WALK to Swami Vivekananda's Residence, seeking Wisdom and Consciousness, on 03.01.2025. The students saw a Light-and-Sound show depicting the mythology of the Child and the Ascetic, his house which included the rooms and furniture used by different members of the family with audio clippings, pictures of his life and travels and his teachings.

Finally, there were two movie shows, depicting his travels throughout India and his Speech at Chicago Conference on World Religions.

The second event was a lecture on the topic "To Do or not to Do: A Quest for Big 'I'" on 13.01.2025. The resource person was Sri Nilavo Roy, Assistant Professor, Department of Economics, Loreto College, Kolkata.

The speaker highlighted certain cardinal principles of Swami Vivekananda pertaining to the youth. These are Living Consciously and Purposefully, Self-Acceptance, Self-Responsibility, Self-Assertiveness and Personal Integrity. He, after Vivekananda, also stressed the importance of doing one's duties as Devotion to Duty is the highest worship of God. The objective was overall enlightenment of the participants.

The final programme was an essay-writing competition entitled 'Swami Vivekananda and the Youth of India' on 13.01.2025 in which the 35 participants highlighted his teachings.
