

EXCURSION CONDUCTED BY BOTANY DEPARTMENT, VIC


A long excursion to the Sundarbans was organized by the Department of Botany, Victoria Institution (College) from 13–15 July 2025, involving Sem-II Major, Sem-II Minor, Sem-IV MDC 200, and Sem-IV Minor 100 level students. The main objective of the excursion was to study vegetation in a distinct phytogeographical zone and collection of plants for preservation as herbarium specimens. Despite persistent rainy weather, all assigned tasks were completed according to the curriculum. Students had valuable field exposure to the unique mangrove ecosystem of Indian Sundarbans. They documented several mangrove species, most of which were in the flowering or fruiting stage. Special attention was paid to halophytic adaptations exhibited by these plants, providing valuable hands-on experience of ecological adaptations to saline environments.


