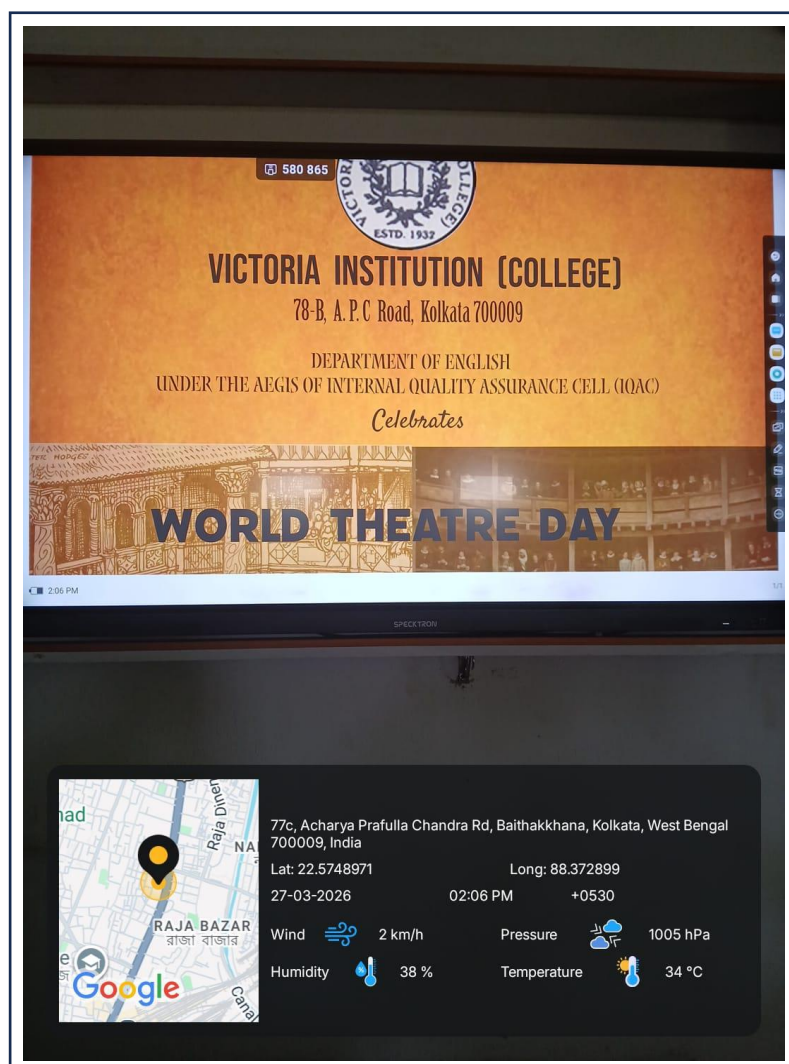


Celebration of World Theatre Day by English Department, VIC
