

Extension Lecture organized by Geography department, VIC

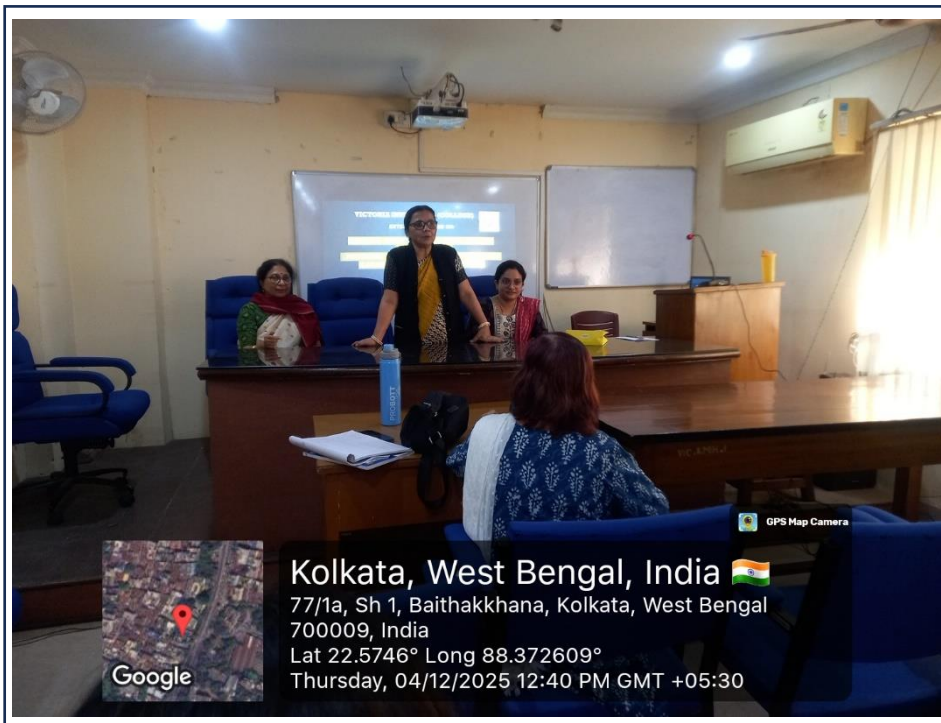
