organized by the Dept. of Physics in collaboration with IQAC on 11.02.2025

The Physics Department in collaboration with IQAC , Victoria Institution College organised a online seminar on 11th Feb, 2025 to commemorate International Day for Women and Girls in Science. On this occasion a multidisciplinary lecturer entitled ‘Flow of energy in living systems’ was delivered by Dr. Anindita Chakraborty, former senior scientist, UGC – DAE CSR, Kolkata centre. Dr. Chakraborty’s talk highlighted the process by which biological energy is assimilated by the plants, through the process of photosynthesis, and the subsequent flow of this energy from one trophic level to another in the ecosystem.

The programme was graced by Principal Dr. Maitryee Ray Kanjilal, who in the welcome address stressed the need of more girls to take up a career in Science. Dr. Sumallya Karmakar, IQAC coordinator spoke about the challenges girls face in the field of STEM and suggested measures to overcome the same. 16 Students and 5 faculty members from the Science departments of our College participated in this online seminar on platform.
