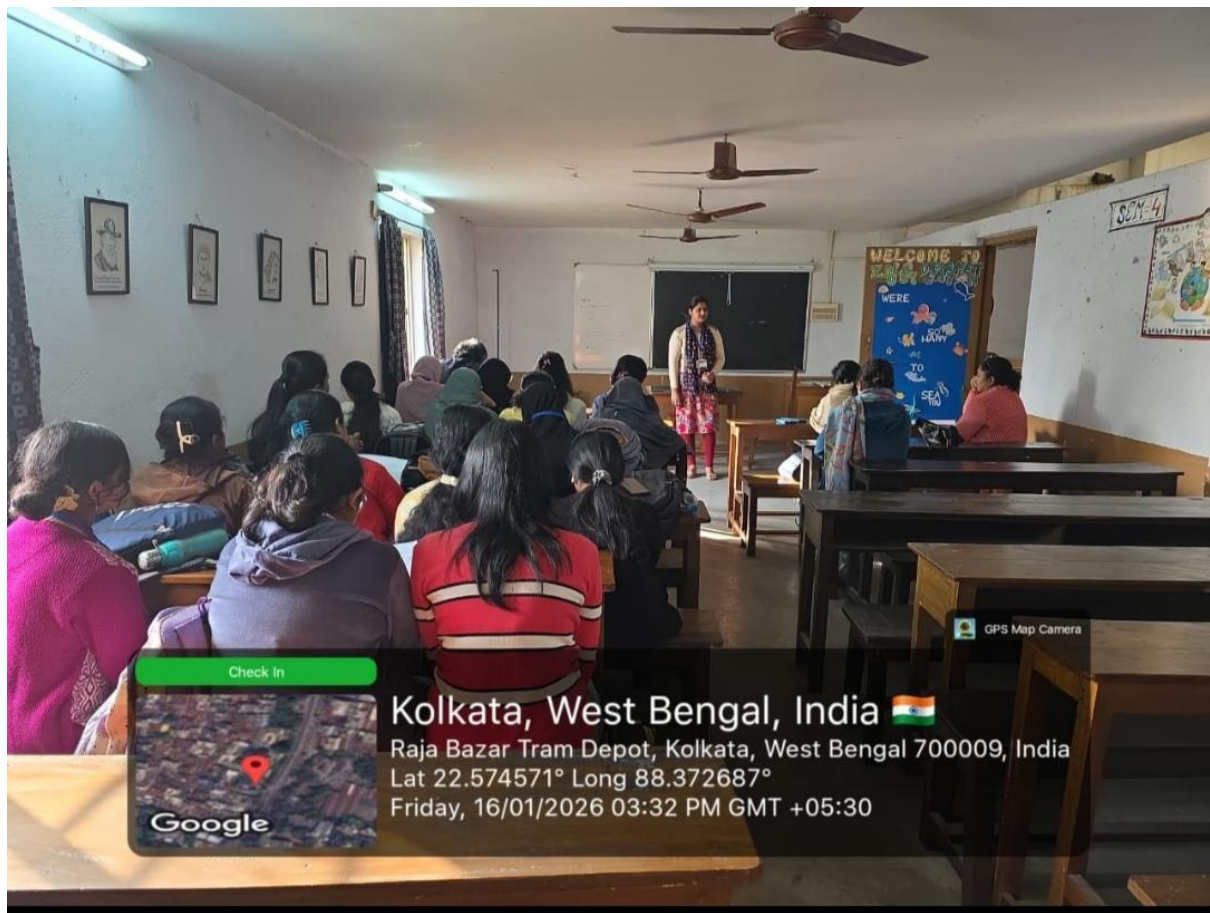


STUDENTS' TALK FOR SEMESTER I MAJOR IN THE DEPARTMENT OF ZOOLOGY
