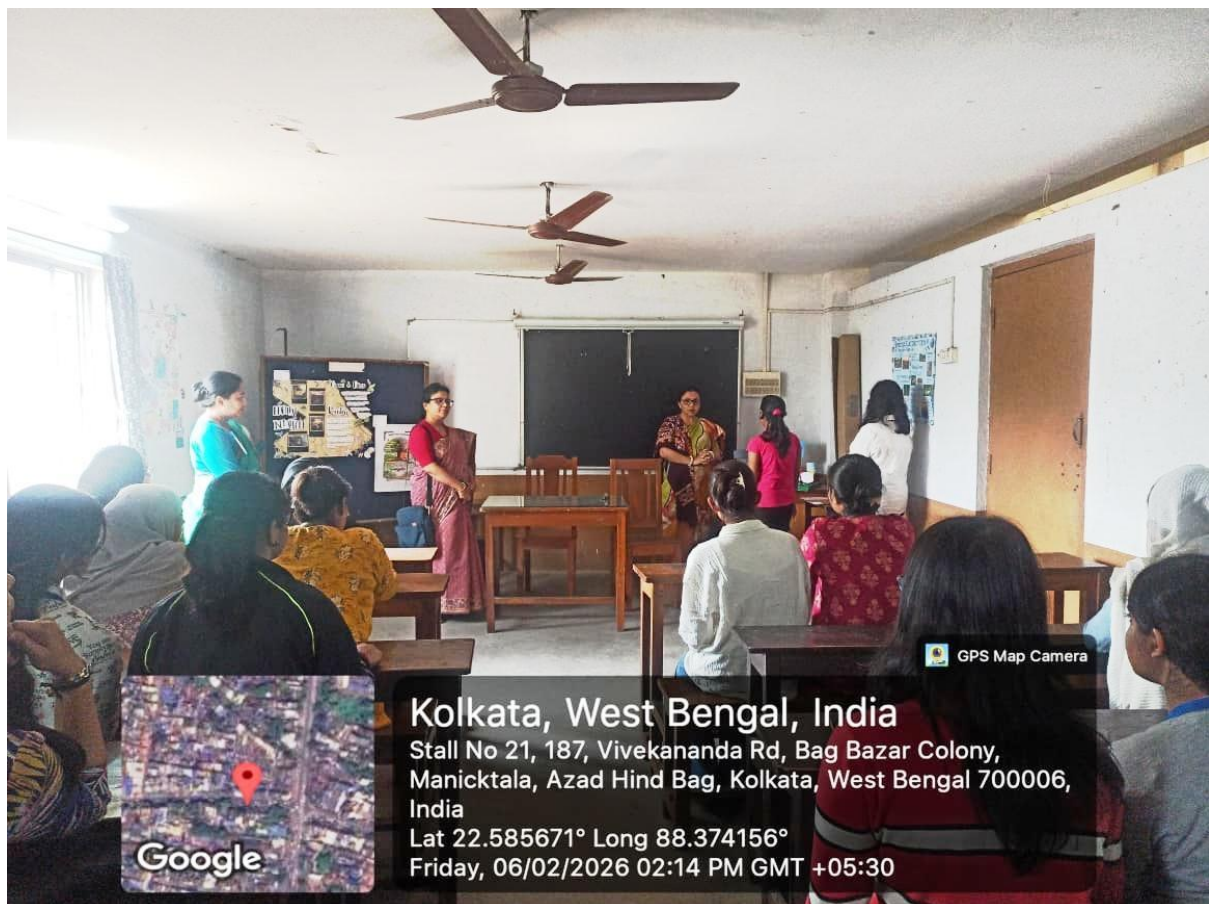


**Unveiling of Wall Magazine-2026 organized by Semester 1 Major students of Zoology

The Wall Magazine of the Department of Zoology, “**ZOO MAG-2026**” was published by the Students of SEMESTER 1 Major on **6th February, 2026**. . Students (21) of Semester 1 Zoology Major unveiled the Wall Magazine-2026, under the guidance of Dr. Debjani Das (Ghosh), Associate Professor in Zoology, VIC on 6th February, 2026. The theme of this year's wall magazine was “**Habitat loss and fragmentation**”. Habitat loss and fragmentation occur when natural landscapes are destroyed or broken into smaller, isolated patches, primarily due to human activities like agriculture and urbanization. This process drastically reduces available living space, forcing wildlife into "islands" of habitat that often cannot sustain large or migratory populations. Furthermore, fragmented landscapes disrupt critical ecosystem services, such as natural pollination and water filtration, which depend on large, contiguous tracts of land. Ultimately, this structural decay of nature is the leading driver of the global biodiversity crisis, making it harder for species to adapt to a changing climate.
