A two-day workshop on “Current Techniques of Biodiversity Study and its Applications” was organised by Department of Zoology, Victoria Institution (College), Kolkata, in collaboration with Kishore Bharati Bhagini Nibedita College (Co-ed), Kolkata on 20th & 21st November, 2025. Total 33 students (22 Zoology Major & 11 MDC Zoology) participated in the workshop to gather hands-on experience in bird counting and butterfly sampling. The theoretical part was presented in Kesub Memorial Hall, Victoria Institution (College) and the practical part was demonstrated at A.J.C.Bose Botanic Garden, Shibpur. The students got the opportunity to observe, identify and record lots of bird and butterfly species. The recorded data was used to calculate species diversity index, which is an important parameter in Biodiversity study. Departmental teachers Dr. Sucharita Saha (Datta) and Smt Suchona Mitra Chakraborty guided the team along with the resource persons Dr. Rudra Prasad Das and Dr. Mousumi Roy from Kishore Bharati Bhagini Nibedita College (CO-ed).
