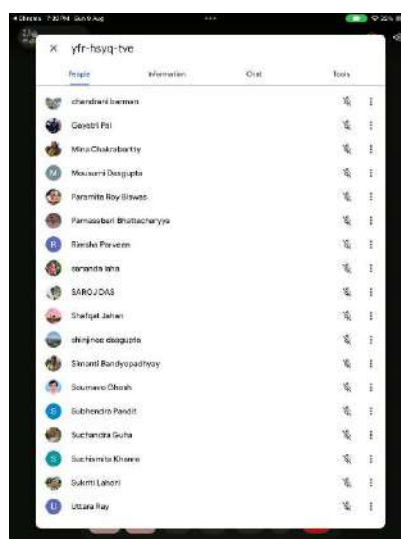
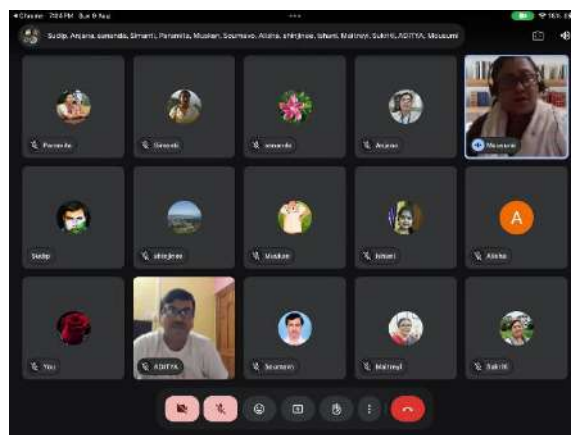

ONLINE SEMINAR dated August 9, 2026
