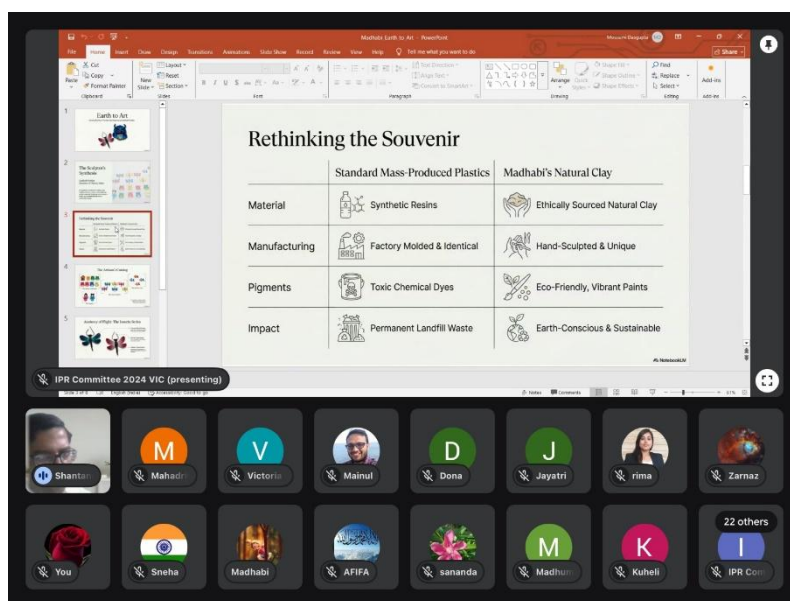
We were privileged to have two distinguished experts lead the session:

making, using, offering for sale, selling or importing the patented invention.

Term: **20 years** from the date of filing.

Jurisdiction: It is a **territorial right**.
