

One Day Awareness Programme on the Provisions of the Transgender Persons (Protection of Rights)

The Women's Cell and Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of Victoria Institution (College), in collaboration with the National Institute of Social Defence under the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Government of India, and the Jayaprakash Institute of Social Change, organized a One Day Awareness Programme on 26th March, 2026 at Suniti Sabhaghar of the college. The programme focused on spreading awareness about the Transgender Persons (Protection of Rights) Act, 2019 and Rules 2020, highlighting key provisions such as recognition of self-perceived gender identity, prohibition of discrimination, welfare measures, and grievance redressal mechanisms. Around sixty participants, including students and faculty members, attended and actively engaged in the sessions. The discussions emphasized the role of educational institutions in fostering inclusivity, equality, and respect for gender diversity. The programme concluded with a renewed commitment to uphold the dignity and rights of transgender persons and to promote a more inclusive academic environment.
