

Report on the Talk: “Gender Justice and the Indian Legal System”

The Gender Sensitization initiative of Victoria Institution (College) was furthered through a talk on “Gender Justice and the Indian Legal System,” organized by the Women’s Cell and IQAC. Shri Nayan Chand Bihani, Senior Advocate, Calcutta High Court, was the distinguished speaker. He explained the constitutional foundations of gender equality and discussed key legislations such as the Domestic Violence Act and the POSH Act. Drawing on his extensive legal experience, he illustrated how courts address discrimination and safeguard women’s rights. He also highlighted continuing challenges, including social biases and limited legal awareness, encouraging students to develop sensitivity and informed citizenship. An interactive session followed, allowing participants to engage meaningfully with the speaker. The programme was well received by the teaching and non-teaching staff and students, and it significantly strengthened their understanding of gender justice.
